Home Start Announces Major Funding from Price Galinson Collaborative Fund

San Diego, CA – Home Start is pleased to announce a major donation of \$30,000 has been granted by the Price Galinson Collaborative Fund for capacity building. Home Start has been dedicated for over 36 years to providing therapeutic and child development services based on home visitation and other “best practice” models. Clients served are lower-income families with children who are at-risk of abuse or neglect or who have experienced maltreatment.

“This major commitment by the Price Galinson Collaborative Fund, will allow us to meet the growing demand throughout San Diego County for evidence-based prevention and treatment services for the children and families who need it most,” said Home Start Chief Executive Officer, Laura A. Mustari, LCSW, “Especially in these challenging economic times, we are extremely grateful for their support”.

This funding will allow Home Start to expand the number of people served by direct service staff who have achieved training and certification in three recognized child abuse prevention and intervention models, Parents as Teachers (PAT), Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) and Trauma-Focused Clinical Behavior Therapy (TF-CBT). All three models are nationally recognized as research-based approaches that foster healthy child development, improve parent-child relationships and reduce the negative psychological impact of abuse or neglect.

Founded in 1972, Home Start, Inc. is a 501 (C) (3) non-profit agency that provides services to children from low income families who require immediate, comprehensive solutions to ensure their safety and healthy development. Our mission is dedicated to child abuse prevention and family strengthening services. Today, Home Start reaches at-risk children right where it counts -- in the home, and then extends the helping hand to schools and the community. Some of our programs include: **Family Support Services** - Parents are taught accurate expectations of their children, how to interact with them and use positive, appropriate discipline. As a result, families are less isolated, more nurturing and cohesive. Parents are strengthened and are better able to protect their children in the future. **Therapeutic Counseling Services** are provided in the home or at our counseling centers. Services are provided on a sliding-fee scale or through the Victim Compensation Fund. **Family Self-Sufficiency Services** provide a "hand-up" rather than a handout by stabilizing families in crisis. Families are helped to move from welfare-to-work, many for the first time in their lives.
